Amtrak Service & Ridership

Amtrak operates one long-distance train through Nebraska, the *California Zephyr* (daily Chicago-Omaha-Lincoln-Denver-Salt Lake City-San Francisco Bay Area).

During FY10 Amtrak served the following Nebraska locations:

Procurement/Contracts

Amtrak placed orders valued at \$479,588 for goods and services in Nebraska in FY10, over half of it in Omaha.

Employment

At the end of FY10, Amtrak employed 20 Nebraska residents. Total wages of Amtrak employees living in Nebraska were \$1,468,928 during FY10.

Station Development

Amtrak supports the City of Lincoln's Vision 2015 Plan for new convention and hotel space in a revitalized Haymarket District downtown. The Vision Plan requires relocation of the BNSF mainline and passenger station used by Amtrak trains serving Lincoln. Amtrak has been in consultation with the City and the project team responsible for the railroad relocation to ensure development of a pleasing replacement station that accommodates present and future growth needs for Amtrak and Lincoln.
