Services on Amtrak Cascades Trains

-  **Coaches: Reservations required.**
-  **Cascades Business Class Service:** Where noted by  symbol.
-  Airport connection.
-  **Sleeping Cars:**
 - Superliner sleeping accommodations on Trains 11 and 14, the Coast Starlight
 - Amtrak's Metropolitan Lounge available in Portland for Sleeping Car Service passengers.
-  **Dining Cars:**
 - Complete meal service on Trains 11, 14, 510 and 517.
-  **Lounge/Bistro Cars:** Sandwiches, snacks and beverages on all trains.
- Entertainment:** Railway Media's digEplayer,[™] available for rent at Seattle and Portland.
- Bicycles:** Trains 500 through 517 are equipped with a limited number of bike racks for carrying unboxed bicycles.
 - Reservation required; service charge applies.
 - The passenger brings the bicycle to and picks it up from the baggage car.
 - Certain connecting Thruway motorcoaches also carry bicycles, consult agent.
-  **Smoking is prohibited entirely on these trains.**

-  Thruway Motorcoach Connections, providing coordinated train/motorcoach service with connections at the Amtrak station (in most cases), as well as through fares/ticketing. Passengers traveling on Thruway connecting motorcoaches must be ticketed before boarding motorcoaches in order to obtain through fares. Greyhound, Northwestern Stages, Olympic Bus Lines, Porter Stage Lines, The Shuttle and Western Trailways of Canada are normally not accessible to passengers in wheelchairs. However, these carriers will provide an accessible vehicle when given 24-48 hours notice. Please consult Amtrak for details.
-  Checked Baggage Service available at stations indicated.
-  Ticket office open for all train departures.
-  Ticket office/checked baggage not open for all departures.
-  Tickets can not be purchased at this location.
-  All station facilities are fully accessible to persons using wheelchairs.
-  Barrier-free access between street or parking lot, station platform and trains; however, not all facilities within the station are fully accessible.
-  Airport connection.
-  Via Connecting Ferry Service.

Operation of Trains 500 through 517 and Thruway motorcoach service between Portland and Eugene is financed primarily through funds made available by the Oregon Department of Transportation, and between Vancouver–Seattle–Portland by the Washington State Department of Transportation.

Passengers holding multi-ride tickets should be aware that reserved and ticketed passengers have priority seating on Amtrak Thruway buses.

CROSSING THE U.S./CANADIAN BORDER Customs and Immigration Information

Proof of citizenship and proof of identity are required. For US and Canadian citizens, a passport is strongly recommended and may be required as early as January 1, 2008 for all land and sea border crossings, including Amtrak trains and Amtrak Thruway services. This date is subject to change by government agencies. (A passport is required now for any border crossing by air.) Otherwise, a certified copy of a birth certificate AND current official government-issued photo identification is required. Citizens of all other countries require a valid passport obtained prior to arrival at the border. Passengers under 18 not traveling with both parents require a notarized letter from any parent not present giving permission to cross the border. Admission into either country is solely at the discretion of border authorities, and possession of required documentation in no way guarantees entry. When you make your cross-border reservation with either Amtrak or VIA Rail Canada, your date of birth, country of citizenship, and identification information will be required; this information is provided to border authorities. For further information and to determine what is required for your particular situation, contact the appropriate U.S. or Canadian government offices prior to travel.
