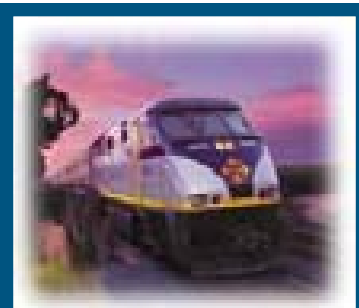
Symbols and Reference Marks

Services on the Capitol Corridor®

- Coaches: Unreserved.
- ☕ Café: Sandwiches, snacks and beverages.
- Bicycles: All trains on the Capitol Corridor are equipped with a limited number of bike racks—passengers may bring bicycles as unboxed carry-on baggage.
 - Available first-come, first-served—no reservations or service charge.
 - Unboxed bicycles may be put in the bin under connecting Thruway motorcoaches. Amtrak disclaims liability for loss or damage.

The Capitol Corridor is primarily financed through funds made available by California State Department of Transportation. The system is managed by the CCJPA-Capitol Corridor Joint Powers Authority-six local transit agencies in the eight county service area and by BART-The San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit District.

Modified Amtrak Service for the Capitol Corridor

During part of May and June, Capitol Corridor schedules may change for a three to four week period to accommodate a track renewal project being performed by Union Pacific Railroad between Martinez and Suisun-Fairfield.
