

Other Carriers' Services to locations not served by Amtrak®

The following connecting local services are available to locations not served by Amtrak. Contact an Amtrak agent or the individual carrier listed for further information.

Newark Airport

Frequent Airlink bus service operates between Amtrak's Newark Station and Newark Airport. (973) 762-5100. Purchase ticket from bus driver.

Harrisburg–Scranton and Reading

Capitol Trailways operates service between Amtrak's Harrisburg Station and Scranton and Reading. (800) 444-2877. Purchase ticket from Trailways agent.

Pittsburgh–New Castle

New Castle Area Transit Authority operates service between New Castle, PA and the Amtrak station in Pittsburgh. Pay fare to driver. Call (724) 654-3130 for schedules.

Philadelphia–Amtrak 30th Street Rail Transfer

SEPTA operates frequent commuter rail service including station stops at 30th Street Station (upper level), Penn Center-Suburban Station and Market East Station-Convention Center. SEPTA honors Amtrak ticket receipts for free local travel between 30th Street Station and either of the two Center City stations. Ticket or ticket receipt must be presented to the SEPTA conductor and remain visible while onboard. For details call SEPTA at (215) 580-7800.

Philadelphia International Airport

SEPTA operates commuter rail service every 30 minutes between the upper level of 30th Street Station and Terminals A, B, C, D, E at Philadelphia Airport. Purchase tickets at SEPTA ticket office or vending machine. SEPTA (215) 580-7800.

Chicago Airports Connections

Chicago Transit Authority (CTA) rapid transit trains provide frequent service to O'Hare and Midway Airports. Blue Line trains to O'Hare leave from the subway station at the corner of Clinton and Congress Streets, two blocks south of Union Station. Orange Line trains to Midway leave from the elevated station at the corner of Quincy and Wells streets, three blocks east of Union Station. Pay fare in CTA station. (312) 836-7000.



- A** Time Symbol for A.M.

-  Thruway Motorcoach Connection. Coordinated train/motorcoach service with connections at the Amtrak station (in most cases), as well as through fares/ticketing. Passengers traveling on Thruway connections must be ticketed before boarding coaches in order to obtain through fares. Motor-coaches are normally not accessible to passengers who use wheelchairs.
- Ticket office open for all train departures.
- Ticket office/checked baggage not open for all departures.
- Tickets can not be purchased at this location.
- ♿ All station facilities are fully accessible to persons using wheelchairs.


