### Pacific Northwest Corridor Services

**Reservations are required on all trains and Thruway motorcoaches between Seattle and Portland, between Seattle and Vancouver, BC, and on Amtrak® Trains 7 and 8 between Spokane and Seattle. Services on board each train are noted with symbols and can be found in the "On Board Service" area.**

- ☑ **Coaches:** Reservations required
- ☑ **Cascades® Business Class Service:** Where noted by ☑ symbol
- ☑ **Sleeping Cars:**
  - First Class Superliner® Service on Trains 11 and 14, the Coast Starlight
  - Amtrak®'s Metropolitan Lounge® available in Portland for First Class Service passengers
- ✂ **Dining Cars:**
  - Complete meal service on Trains 11, 14, 510 and 517
- ☑ **Lounge/Bistro services:** Sandwiches, snacks and beverages on all trains
- ☑ **Entertainment:** Feature movies and music
- ☑ **Railfone:** Public telephone service available on Trains 501 through 517
- ☑ **Bicycles:** Trains 500 through 517 are equipped with a limited number of bike racks for carrying unboxed bicycles
  - Reservation required; service charge applies
  - The passenger brings the bicycle to and picks it up from the baggage car
  - Certain connecting Thruway motorcoaches also carry bicycles, consult agent.
- ☑ **Smoking is prohibited entirely on these trains and Thruway motorcoaches**

### Symbols and Reference Marks

- A** Time Symbol for A.M.
- D** Stops only to discharge passengers.
- P** Time Symbol for P.M.
- MT** Mountain Time
- PT** Pacific Time
- R** Stops only to receive passengers.
- ☑ Thruway Motorcoach Connections, providing coordinated train/motorcoach service with connections at the Amtrak station (in most cases), as well as through fares/ticketing. Passengers traveling on Thruway connecting motorcoaches must be ticketed before boarding motorcoaches in order to obtain through fares. Northwestern Trailways and Porter Stage Lines Thruway services are normally not accessible to passengers who use wheelchairs.
- ☑ Checked Baggage Service available at stations indicated.
- Ticket office open for all train departures.
- Ticket office/checked baggage not open for all departures.
- Tickets can not be purchased at this location.
- ♿ All station facilities are fully accessible to persons using wheelchairs.
- ♿ Barrier-free access between street or parking lot, station platform and trains; however, not all facilities within the station are fully accessible.
- ☑ Via Connecting Ferry Service.
- ☑ Thruway motorcoach arrives Tacoma 5:30 p.m.
- ☑ Will not operate 11/24, 12/26/05 and 1/2/06.
- ☑ Will also operate 11/24, 12/26/05 and 1/2/06.
