- Quik-Trak self-serve ticketing kiosk available for credit/debit card sales.
- Checked Baggage Service available at stations indicated.**
- Thruway Motorcoach Connection. Coordinated train/motorcoach service with connections at the Amtrak station (in most cases), as well as through fares/ticketing. Passengers traveling on Thruway connections must be ticketed before boarding coaches in order to obtain through fares. Motorcoaches are normally not accessible to passengers who use wheelchairs.
- Ticket office open for all train departures.
- Ticket office/checked baggage not open for all train departures.
- Tickets can not be purchased at this location.
- All station facilities are fully accessible to persons who use wheelchairs.
