
-  **Coaches:** Reservations required.
-  **Sleeping cars:** Viewliner sleeping accommodations - Amtrak's Metropolitan Lounge/ClubAcela available in Chicago, New York and Boston for Sleeping car Service passengers.
-  **Dining:** Casual service offering complete meals and appetizers with an all day menu on Trains 48 and 49 between New York and Chicago. Not available between Albany and Boston; Sleeping car passengers will receive complimentary cold meal service.
-  **Lounge:** Sandwiches, snacks and beverages. Combined Diner/Lounge provides food and beverage service between New York and Albany.

-  Thruway Motorcoach Connection. Coordinated train/motorcoach service with connections at the Amtrak station (in most cases), as well as through fares/ticketing. Passengers traveling on Thruway connections must be ticketed before boarding coaches in order to obtain through fares. Motorcoaches are normally not accessible to passengers who use wheelchairs.
- Ticket office open for all train departures.
- Tickets can not be purchased at this location.
-  All station facilities are fully accessible to persons who use wheelchairs.
-  Barrier-free access between street or parking lot, station platform and trains; however, not all facilities within the station are fully accessible.
-  Monday-Friday, Train departs New York at 4:00 p.m., Croton Harmon at 4:43 p.m., and arrives Albany at 6:30 p.m. Weekday train will not operate on 11/27/08, 12/25/08, 1/1/09 and 2/16/09. Train will operate on schedules shown above on these dates.

Connecting Local Services

Chicago Airport Connections

Chicago Transit Authority (CTA) rapid transit trains provide frequent service to O'Hare and Midway Airports. Blue Line trains to O'Hare leave from the subway station at the corner of Clinton and Congress Streets, two blocks south of Union Station. Orange Line trains to Midway leave from the elevated station at the corner of Quincy and Wells streets, three blocks east of Union Station. Pay fare in CTA station. New York Airport Connections

New York Airport Service provides Thruway motorcoach service between Pennsylvania Station, New York and both J.F. Kennedy and LaGuardia Airports. Coaches depart Pennsylvania Station to each airport every half hour from 7:40 a.m. to 8:10 p.m., daily. Allow at least an hour travel time to J.F. Kennedy or LaGuardia Airports.
