Amtrak Service & Ridership

Amtrak operates three National Network trains through Arizona:

- The *Southwest Chief* (daily Chicago-Los Angeles via Flagstaff)
- The *Sunset Limited* (tri-weekly Orlando-New Orleans-Tucson-Los Angeles)*
- The *Texas Eagle* (daily Chicago-Dallas-San Antonio with through car service tri-weekly via the *Sunset Limited* to Los Angeles, with stops in Benson, Tucson, Maricopa, and Yuma)

*Sunset Limited service suspended east of New Orleans.

During FY16 Amtrak served the following Arizona locations:

Procurement/Contracts

Amtrak spent \$2,829,730 on goods and services in Arizona in FY16. Most of this, \$2,531,649, was in Scottsdale.

Employment

At the end of FY16, Amtrak employed 16 Arizona residents. Total wages of Amtrak employees living in Arizona were \$1,652,471 during FY16.
