Upcoming Activities

Clearing and Grubbing

This week contractors will begin clearing and grubbing at various locations throughout the Program area. Clearing and grubbing is the removal of vegetation, such as trees, shrubs, and brush, roots, stumps, and other underground systems to provide a solid base and better visibility for the remainder of construction.

Fence Installation

Starting in December 2024, crews will begin to install construction fencing for the utility relocation work that will take place as a part of the Program in early 2025. The early fencing will be erected in the vicinity of the 700 block of Pulaski Street.

- We will maintain pedestrian access while work is being completed
- There may be temporary sidewalk closures required.
- We will provide signage to indicate the location of the temporary closures as work progresses.

Demolition

- Demolition is continuing at 700 N. Pulaski Street with the removal of building foundation and backfilling.
- This work is not anticipated to impact the surrounding sidewalks or traffic patterns.
- There may be an increase in truck traffic and dust during the demolition. We plan to mitigate the increased dust with the use of watering hoses when necessary.

Noise and Vibration Monitoring

To gather critical information about the existing conditions near the construction site, crews will continue placing noise and vibration monitoring equipment in public areas. This equipment will

be in place for short periods of time to allow the team to gather baseline noise and vibration data prior to the start of major construction activities.

Ongoing Activities

Crews will continue to conduct surveys, install E&S Controls, complete preconstruction inspections, conduct test pitting, and complete utility investigations throughout the project area.
