Upcoming Activities

Mobilization

Starting in December 2024, crews will begin to mobilize in the 700 block of N. Pulaski St in preparation for the upcoming water line relocation. This mobilization work includes bringing in equipment and materials and installing construction fencing around the perimeter of the work area. There will be an increase in contractors in the area as work ramps up.

- We will maintain pedestrian access while work is being completed
- Temporary sidewalk closures may be required
- We will provide signage to indicate the location of any traffic modifications

Ongoing Activities

Test Pitting

Crews will dig test pits (small holes through the pavement to locate existing utilities) in the area near the location for the Intermediate Ventilation Facility (W. North Ave, Linden Ave, Eutaw St) and West Baltimore MARC Station (Franklin and Mulberry Sts). This work will continue for several weeks.

- Crews will generally work Monday through Friday 9:00am to 3:00pm, weather permitting
- During construction you may see traffic lane shifts, an increase in traffic, construction noise, and dust

- Please adhere to the posted no parking signs and use caution when traveling through this area

Clearing and Grubbing

Contractors will continue to clear and remove vegetation such as trees, shrubs and brush, roots, stumps, and other underground systems to provide a solid base and better visibility for the remainder of construction. Crews will clear and grub within Amtrak property and beneath the Lafayette Ave bridge. No traffic impacts are expected from this work.

Noise and Vibration Monitoring

To gather critical information about the existing conditions near the construction site, crews will continue placing noise and vibration monitoring equipment in the Program area. This equipment will gather baseline noise and vibration data prior to the start of major construction activities and then will gather data for the duration of construction to help inform the Program.
