

WEST BALTIMORE MARC STATION

FIRST LOOK



The new West Baltimore MARC station is a key element of the Frederick Douglass Tunnel Program. This program will modernize a 10 mile section of the Amtrak's Northeast Corridor in Baltimore. The new station will be constructed approximately 100 feet west of the existing station and will include amenities as listed below.

FUTURE STATION FEATURES

- Restrooms
- Platform canopies
- Wider sidewalks
- Ticket Vending Machines
- ADA-accessible, improved connectivity to neighborhoods
- Public art opportunities
- Under bridge lighting
- Connectivity between MARC Train, MTA Bus, future Red Line
- Temperature controlled waiting areas
- Enhanced pickup/drop off
- Bike storage
- Reduced travel time between Baltimore and Washington, D.C.
