DEPLOYMENT STRATEGY

Amtrak is procuring three new single-level car types—**Standard Coach Car, High-Capacity Coach Car, and Café Car**—to integrate with its existing fleet and support a wide range of service needs across Long Distance, Northeast Corridor (NEC), and State Supported routes. The procurement includes a base order, with additional option quantities allowing for future scalability and operational flexibility. The intended deployment for each car type is outlined below:

High-Capacity Coach Car

These cars will be used exclusively on the NEC in the base order, supporting high-volume corridor operations. Option quantities are planned to meet future growth across NEC and State Supported services. There is also potential for later introduction on Long Distance routes, particularly to serve short-segment or high-density demand.

Standard Coach Car

Most of these cars in the base order are allocated to Long Distance services, where they will provide overnight coach seating. A smaller number will be deployed on NEC and State Supported routes, where they will operate as Business Class. Long Distance remains the primary application for this car type across the full program.

Café Car

These cars will be distributed across both Long Distance and NEC/State Supported services. In the base order, the majority will serve Long Distance routes. In the option orders, the balance shifts toward NEC and State Supported services.

This deployment strategy balances current service requirements with flexibility for future network needs, ensuring each car type is used where it delivers the greatest operational benefit.





Designed for Dual Use


Our new versatile cafe cars are designed for connection and relaxation on long-distance journeys. With seats and tables for dining, they provide a comfortable space to eat, unwind, or enjoy the journey. On Corridor services, these same seats are brought into

revenue use, offering a smart, dualpurpose layout. The car is fully accessible from end to end, including a café counter designed at an accessible height.



CAFE CAR SEATING

Café car seating uses the same High Capacity Coach seat. The seat should be suitable for café use on long-distance routes, while also enabling revenue service on Corridor lines. The 2+1 layout, made possible by the wider accessible pathway, creates additional space that could be optimized. There is scope to explore how this extra width might enhance the café experience, whether through refined seating or smart integration of surrounding elements.





CAFE COUNTER

Featuring a spacious open counter at an accessible height, this prominent area is designed to create a welcoming and passenger-friendly atmosphere, both in front of and behind the counter.

To accommodate future food service opportunities, such as 'grab and go' options, the counter is intentionally kept clear of equipment. Conveniently placed at queuing points and point of purchase, digital menu screens, connected to live data, provide up-to-date menus, promotions, and general information.

A range of thoughtfully designed restrooms have been designed on board to ensure that every passenger's needs are met with comfort and convenience. Our commitment to passenger






Given the versatile deployment strategy—serving multiple service lines and connecting with both legacy and new fleet types—the material approach must be flexible and cohesive.


Applications will need to complement a range of car types and class offerings, including Airo, Viewliner and Venture fleets, ensuring a unified experience across the network.
