Amtrak Service & Ridership

Amtrak operates three National Network trains through Arizona:

- The *Southwest Chief* (daily Chicago-Los Angeles via Flagstaff)
- The *Sunset Limited* (tri-weekly Orlando-New Orleans-Tucson-Los Angeles)*
- The *Texas Eagle* (daily Chicago-Dallas-San Antonio with through car service tri-weekly via the *Sunset Limited* to Los Angeles, with stops in Benson, Tucson, Maricopa, and Yuma)

*Sunset Limited *service suspended east of New Orleans.*

Procurement/Contracts

Amtrak spent \$1,736,914 on goods and services in Arizona in FY15, most of it in Scottsdale, \$1,630,964.

Employment

At the end of FY15, Amtrak employed 18 Arizona residents. Total wages of Amtrak employees living in Arizona were \$1,920,550 during FY15.
