Amtrak Service & Ridership

Amtrak operates three National Network trains through Arizona:

- The *Southwest Chief* (daily Chicago-Los Angeles via Flagstaff)
- The *Sunset Limited* (tri-weekly Orlando-New Orleans-Tucson-Los Angeles)*
- The *Texas Eagle* (daily Chicago-Dallas-San Antonio with through car service tri-weekly via the *Sunset Limited* to Los Angeles, with stops in Benson, Tucson, Maricopa, and Yuma)

*Sunset Limited service suspended east of New Orleans.

During FY17 Amtrak served the following Arizona locations:

Procurement

Amtrak spent \$13,890,644 on goods and services in Arizona in FY17. Most of this was in the following locations:

Employment

At the end of FY17, Amtrak employed 22 Arizona residents. Total wages of Amtrak employees living in Arizona were \$1,533,938 during FY17.

Thruway Bus service

In FY17, Amtrak began operating a new thruway shuttle service in Maricopa connecting *Sunset Limited/Texas Eagle* passengers to Phoenix and Tempe. The new shuttle service operates on the scheduled days the train operates through Maricopa.
