### Amtrak Service & Ridership

Amtrak operates two National Network trains through Kentucky:

- The *Cardinal* (tri-weekly Chicago-Cincinnati-New York via Ashland)
- The *City of New Orleans* (daily Chicago-Memphis-New Orleans via Fulton)

During FY15 Amtrak served the following Kentucky locations:

### Procurement/Contracts

Amtrak spent \$9,024,360 on goods and services in Kentucky in FY15. Most of this, \$7,477,738, was in Louisville.

### Employment

At the end of FY15, Amtrak employed 2 Kentucky residents. Total wages of Amtrak employees living in Kentucky were \$132,586 during FY15.

### Station Improvements

**Improving ADA Accessibility:** Amtrak will undertake work at multiple stations in Kentucky to assess, design, and construct improvements at and around stations as part of Amtrak's nationwide Americans with Disabilities Act compliance plan. The projected FY16 ADA-related work includes:

- **Design:** South Shore-South Portsmouth
- **Construction:** Maysville
