### Amtrak Service & Ridership

Amtrak serves Mississippi with three National Network trains:

- The *City of New Orleans* (daily Chicago-New Orleans via Jackson)
- The *Crescent* (daily New Orleans-Atlanta-New York via Meridian)
- The *Sunset Limited* (tri-weekly Orlando-New Orleans-Los Angeles via Biloxi)\*

\* Sunset Limited *service suspended east of New Orleans.*

Amtrak spent \$184,609 on goods and services in Mississippi in FY15.

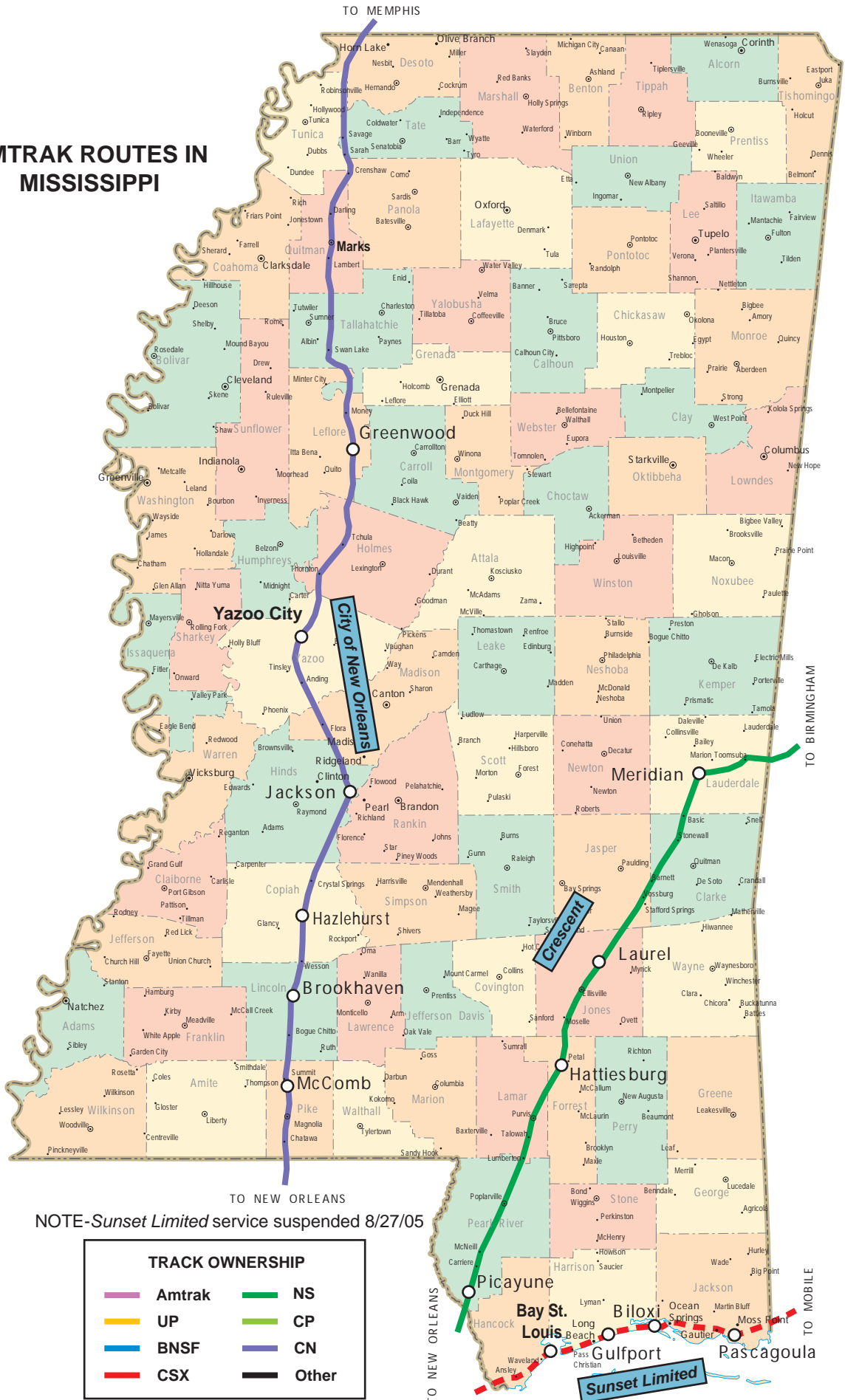
### Employment
