Amtrak Service & Ridership

Amtrak operates one National Network train through Tennessee, the *City of New Orleans* (daily Chicago-Memphis-New Orleans).

During FY15 Amtrak served the following Tennessee locations:

Procurement/Contracts

Amtrak spent \$4,181,245 on goods and services in Tennessee in FY15. Most of this was in the following locations:

Knoxville	\$ 1,881,517

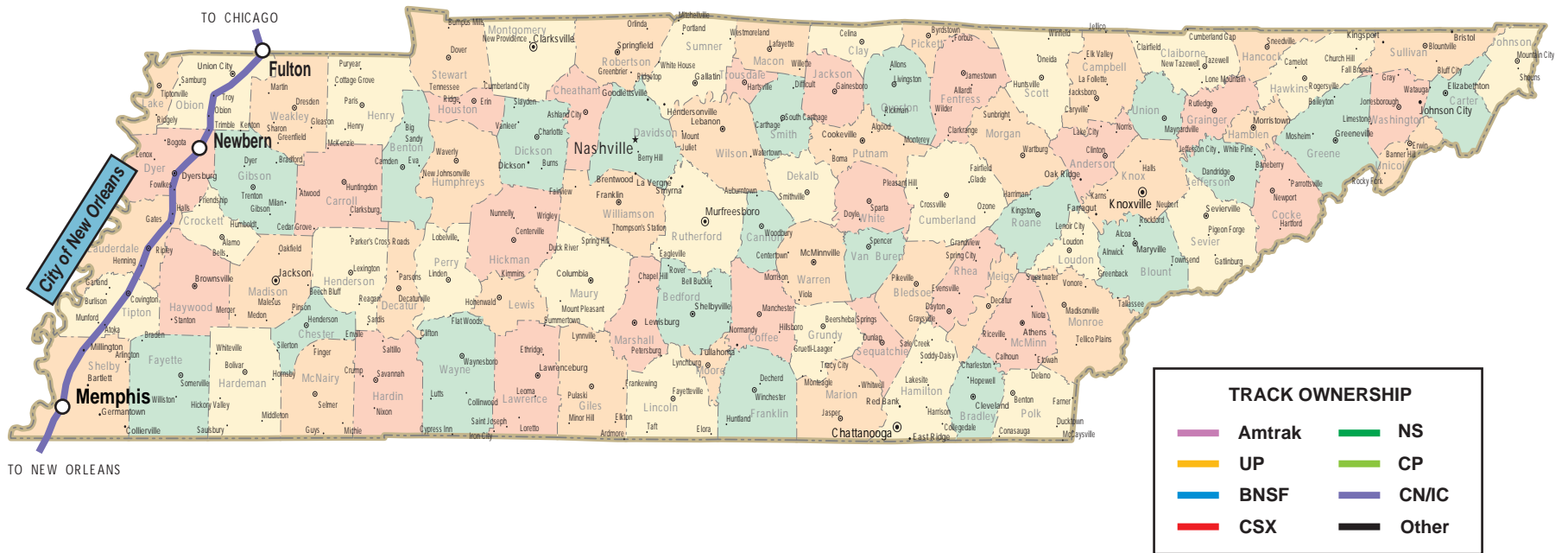
Employment

At the end of FY15, Amtrak employed 10 Tennessee residents. Total wages of Amtrak employees living in Tennessee were \$991,144 during FY15.
