



# Amtrak Fact Sheet Fiscal Year 2018 *State of Utah*

## Amtrak Service & Ridership

Amtrak operates one National Network train through Utah:

- The **California Zephyr** (daily Chicago-Omaha-Denver-Salt Lake City-Reno-Emeryville/Oakland-San Francisco Bay area).

During FY18 Amtrak served the following Utah locations:

## Host Railroads & On Time Performance

Amtrak relies heavily on the cooperation of other railroads in order to operate routes using tracks that are not owned or controlled by Amtrak. Host railroads are statutorily required to provide Amtrak trains "preference" over freight transportation. However, on time performance on most host railroads is poor and continues to decline largely due to hosts ignoring their statutory responsibilities.

Listed below are the Amtrak services that operate in Utah with each service's host railroads and on-time performance (OTP) in FY18:

<b>Service</b>	<b>Host Railroads</b>	<b>FY18 OTP</b>
<b>California Zephyr</b>	BNSF and Union Pacific	<b>48.8%</b>

"On-time performance" represents the percentage of stations at which the train arrives within 15 minutes of the scheduled arrival time.

## Amtrak Guest Rewards

At the end of FY18, there were **16,558** members of the Amtrak Guest Rewards program in Utah. This is a 15.6% increase from FY17.
