### Amtrak Service & Ridership

Amtrak operates two National Network trains daily in West Virginia:

- The *Capitol Limited* (daily Washington-Martinsburg-Pittsburgh-Chicago)
- The *Cardinal* (tri-weekly New York-Washington-Charleston-Cincinnati-Chicago)

### Procurement/Contracts

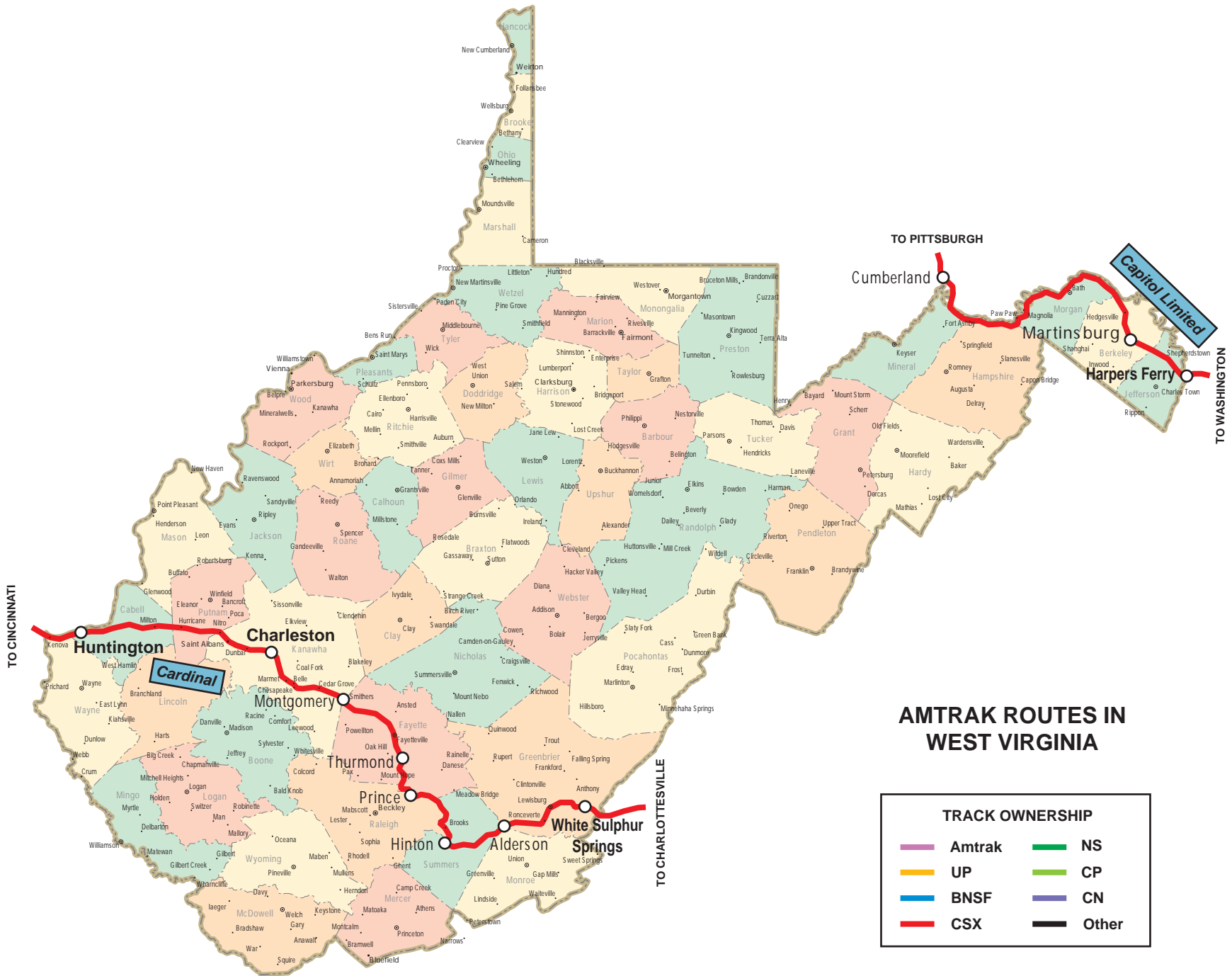
Amtrak spent \$3,815,271 on goods and services in West Virginia in FY15, most of it in Huntington, \$3,491,436.

### Employment

At the end of FY15, Amtrak employed 40 West Virginia residents. Total wages of Amtrak employees living in West Virginia were \$3,449,301 during FY15.

## **Station Improvements**

**Improving ADA Accessibility:** Amtrak will undertake work at and around stations as part of Amtrak's nationwide Americans with Disabilities Act compliance plan. In FY16, Amtrak will begin the design phase for these improvements at and around the Harpers Ferry and Montgomery stations.
