NOTE--Due to an exemption to state law, passengers may travel locally between Lake Tahoe, Placerville or Sacramento without the requirement to buy a train ticket. Passengers traveling to/from Sacramento will be ticketed at Sacramento. All standard discounts are available. Adult passengers between Lake Tahoe and Placerville may buy a ticket from the driver for \$20.00 cash fare each way. Children are half price and no other discounts apply.

**Transit Transfers and Discounted Travel on Local Transit**

- Connections to local transit with Capitol Corridor Transit Transfer Ticket (ask conductor for two free transfers) – Ride free on East Bay AC Transit buses, Contra Costa County Connection, Sacramento RT buses and light rail, e-Tran, Rio Vista Delta Breeze, WestCAT, Yolobus, UC Davis Unitrans, Santa Clara VTA light rail and buses, Fairfield-Suisun Transit and Tri Delta Transit. Transfer is valid through the following day.
  - Clipper Card – Pre-Loaded Clipper cards are available for purchase in Café Car – \$11 value (\$3 new card fee waived). The Clipper card is accepted on many Capitol Corridor Connections, including BART, SF Muni, San Francisco Bay Ferry.
  - SFMTA Tokens (Muni) – Discounted Muni tokens are available in the Café Car and offer travel throughout San Francisco. Limit two per customer.
  - ACE Shuttle Service – Connection available at Santa Clara-Great America station; Capitol Corridor Transit Transfer Ticket not required.

# CAPITOL CORRIDOR



The Capitol Corridor is an intercity passenger train system that provides a convenient alternative to traveling along the congested I-80, I-680 and I-880 freeways by operating fast, reliable and affordable intercity rail

service to 17 stations in 8 Northern California counties: Placer, Sacramento, Yolo, Solano, Contra Costa, Alameda, San Francisco, and Santa Clara, a 170-mile rail corridor. An extensive, dedicated motor coach network provides bus connections to serve the second-largest urban service area in the Western United States.

The Capitol Corridor Joint Powers Authority (CCJPA) is a partnership among the six local transit agencies in the eight-county service area which shares the administration and management of the Capitol Corridor. The San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit District (BART) provides day-to-day management support to the CCJPA.

Capitol Corridor services are developed with input from our riders, private and public sector stakeholders, along with the partners who help deliver the Capitol Corridor service – Amtrak, the Union Pacific Railroad, Caltrans and the various agencies and communities that make up the Capitol Corridor.
